

## **CM Points Under Category 7 “Other Activities”**

The following activities currently receive CM points under this category:

- JOEH journal article reviewer = .5 point per review
- JOEH Action Level participant = .5 CM point per quarter
- ACGIH-Co-op Book Review Panel = .5 point per review
- Workplace HR & Safety participant = .5 CM point per 12 articles
- AIHA Synergist Test Series = 1.0 CM point per 11 articles
- Writing questions for the CIH, CSP, OHST, CHST and STS examinations = 1.0 CM point per 5 acceptable questions/5 points maximum per year.
- AIHCE session arranger = .5 CM point
- ABIH item writing workshop = .5 CM point per .5 day
- Peer reviewed journal column editor/book reviewer = .5 CM point per review
- Participation in an ABIH approved formal mentoring program
- Pro-bono activity - 40 hours = .5 CM point/per year (includes IH practice/consultations, surveys, audits, sampling, etc. performed as a community service not as part of a regular job or continuing education and not for pay).
- Passing other certifications which include the following:

CHMM/Certified Hazardous Materials Manager = 2.5 CM points

CIEC/Certified Indoor Environmental Consultant = 2.5 CM points

CMC/Council-certified Microbial Consultant = 2.5 CM points

CET/Certified Environmental, Safety & Health Trainer = 2.5 CM points

CPE/Certified Professional Ergonomist = 5.0 CM points

CPEA/Certified Professional Environmental Auditor = 5.0 CM points

CSP/Certified Safety Professional = 5.0 CM points

QEP/Qualified Environmental Professional = 5.0 CM points

American Board of Preventive Medicine/Occupational Medicine = 5.0 CM points

Points claimed during a CM cycle must have been accrued during the cycle.

ABIH awards CM points for other certifications if the following criteria are met:

The certification board is national/international in scope. The eligibility requirements include an educational component. A written examination is required. The certification is related to the IH Content Domains (subject areas). The certification program is third-party accredited by an organization such as the Council of Engineering and Scientific Specialty Boards, National Commission for Certifying Agencies or American National Standards Institute.

Other professional activities not covered under Categories 1-6 or not listed above may be eligible for points. Please submit a description of the activity and why you believe it should be awarded CM points.
